

to enter the lobby.




I will go through a security check.

My ticket will have a letter and a number.


That is how I will know which seat to sit in.

An usher will be at the door to help me find my seat.


My seat may be down the hall or up the stairs.

The lights will change, and the show will begin.




During the show, I will see actors dancing and singing on the stage and in the aisles.

I might use the bathroom...




...go for a walk, or stay in my seat.
